- Sanctioned By:** Held under the sanction of USA Swimming and Florida Gold Coast Swimming, Inc. Sanction No. **FG???**
- Sponsored By:** FLA Aquatics
- Rules:** 2014 USA Swimming and FGC rules will govern this meet. Safety rules as outlined by USA swimming and as recommended by the referee will be in effect.
- Except where venue facilities require otherwise, changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is not appropriate and is prohibited.
- Camera Free:** The Florida Gold Coast Swimming **CAMERA FREE ZONE** policy is in effect at this meet. No person may use a camera or any other device capable of recording still or video images in the area behind the starting blocks, in the locker rooms, changing areas, showers or restrooms. Violators may be reported to law enforcement or other governmental authorities and/or may be barred from the facility during the sanctioned event.
- Eligibility:** Open to all current 2014 USA swimming registered athletes and foreign athletes with proper travel credentials who have been invited by USA Swimming. Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member - coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer’s legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement - USA Swimming Rule 202.3.3
The Meet Host **WILL NOT** be accepting New or Renewing USA Swimming registrations at the meet. All USA Registrations must be done prior to the start of the competition.
- Disability:** All swimmers are welcome at this meet. Any athlete with a disability will be accommodated. Please contact the pool office ahead of time to allow for preparations - 954-468-5590—DDillon@FLAswim.com
- Pool / Timing:** 50 meters x 25 yards heated outdoor pool, 10 **Short Course** lanes and with separate warm-up and swim-down lanes available. (Colorado Timing System®) will be used. Fly-over starts will possibly be used. |
The competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2 (C).
Water depth at the start varies from 5’0” to 5’0” depending on lane assignment accordance with 202.3.7 (C).

Follow the road as it S curves past soccer field on left, make left at pedestrian crossing light and follow road straight ahead Parking Lot 15. Pool straight ahead baseball stadium to left parking available in front of aquatic complex.

Entries Close - **Monday – Sept 29, 2014.**

Entry Procedure:

Please, enter electronically (Team Unify, Hy-Tek, CL, SDIF format only).

Non-electronic MAILED entries are not accepted.

Submission of electronic entries certifies that all entered swimmers are current year USA Swimming registered. Confirmation for electronic entries will be sent via e-mail.

Swimmers without registration numbers or birth dates will not be entered.

NOTE: Swimmers without registration numbers or birth dates will not be entered.

***** Entry Fees will be Double if not entered electronically.**

Seeding:

Short Course (25) yards. Special Queen and King of the Hill Seeding. The fastest seeded swimmer in the heat will swim in lane 1, the 2nd fastest in lane 2, and so on thru the 10th fastest in lane 10. All events will be seeded ALL ages together, fastest to slowest; but be awarded by age group.

Entry Fees:

\$4.00 per Individual event entry

\$7.50 per swimmer surcharge

Entry fees are made payable to “FLA Aquatics” (note: one check per team)

Refunds:

Once a team or individual entry has been received and processed, there will be no refunds in full or in part.

Entry Limit:

Five (5) individual events per day plus relays.

Distance Events: *All Friday events and the 1650 FR on Sunday will be **positive check-in**. For the 1650; Heat 1 will swim 1 swimmer per lane. All remaining heats will swim 2 swimmers per lane.*

Swimmers in the 500 FR, 400 IM, and 1650 must provide their own timer and their own counter.

Relays:** *Mixed relays need to have at least one (1) girl and at least one (1) boy; 4 swimmers*

Deck Entries: THE FGC DECK SEED POLICY WILL BE IN EFFECT. Deck entries permitted into open lanes only on a first-come-first-serve basis. Deadline for deck entries is 30 min. before start of meet. Policy can be seen at www.fgcswwim.org. All deck entered swimmers must present current USA Swimming Card in order to be entered.
